

# Driving to Camp Spoonhowopic

## From Pittsburgh

Take the **Parkway North** (I-279) to **I-79 North**. When you reach I-90 (just before Erie), take **I-90 East**, then continue with "From Erie & Cleveland" below.

## From Erie & Cleveland

From the Erie (ERI) airport or Cleveland, take **I-90 East**. From Erie, take I-90 for about 12 miles; from Cleveland, take I-90 for about 92 miles. In either case, exit at **Exit 37 to I-86 / Route 17 East**. Take I-86 for about 68 miles. Continue with "The End" below.

## From Buffalo

From the Buffalo (BUF) airport, take **Route 33 West** for about 1.5 miles. Take **I-90 West** (NYS Thruway) towards Erie for about 7.5 miles. Follow the split on the right to **Route 219 South**. (Stay in the center lane after the split.) Do not speed through Boston.

Stay on Route 219 through Springville and Ellicottville to Salamanca. Coming into Salamanca you will see the junction of I-86 / Route 17. This is a **left** turn around a triangular island. Take the first entrance to the **I-86 / Route 17 West** toward Jamestown. Then continue with "The End" below.

## From Rochester

Take **I-390 South**. Take **Exit 4 for Route 36 South**. Follow Route 36 toward Hornell. From there, take **I-86 / Route 17 West** towards Jamestown. Continue with "The End" below.

## From the East (NYC, Conn., Mass., Eastern PA, etc.)

The best approach to the park from the east is on I-86. Campers from New England and the mid-Atlantic will probably take some combination of I-81, I-84, and I-88. From there, get on **I-86 / Route 17 West** and head toward Jamestown. Continue with "The End" below.

## The End

Exit from I-86 / Route 17 at **Exit 18**, Allegany State Park, Quaker Area, Route 280. Go **south** on **Route 280**. Follow Route 280 approximately 4.5 miles to Quaker Lake (on your left). Go **straight** along the lake into the park. Do *not* follow Route 280 to the right.

Register your car at the entrance gate if necessary (see below). Once through the gate, this road becomes **ASP 3**. Continue on ASP 3 and watch for the Camp Turner sign and driveway on the **left** after the end of Quaker Lake. If you get to Weller Trail, you've passed Camp Turner. The Fancher cottages are about 1.5 miles farther down ASP 3. If you arrive anytime on Friday or after 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, proceed directly to Camp Turner regardless of where you are staying. If you arrive before 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, meet us at Fancher A.

Car fees: If you are staying at Camp Turner, you will need to pay a fee to register your car at the park gate. If you are staying at Weller or Fancher, your fee is included with your cabin rental: let the person at the gate know that you have a reservation. If you're arriving late at night, there probably won't be anyone there; you can register your car the following day.
